

The Pacific Mesothelioma Center's New Board Members Join the Fight Against Mesothelioma

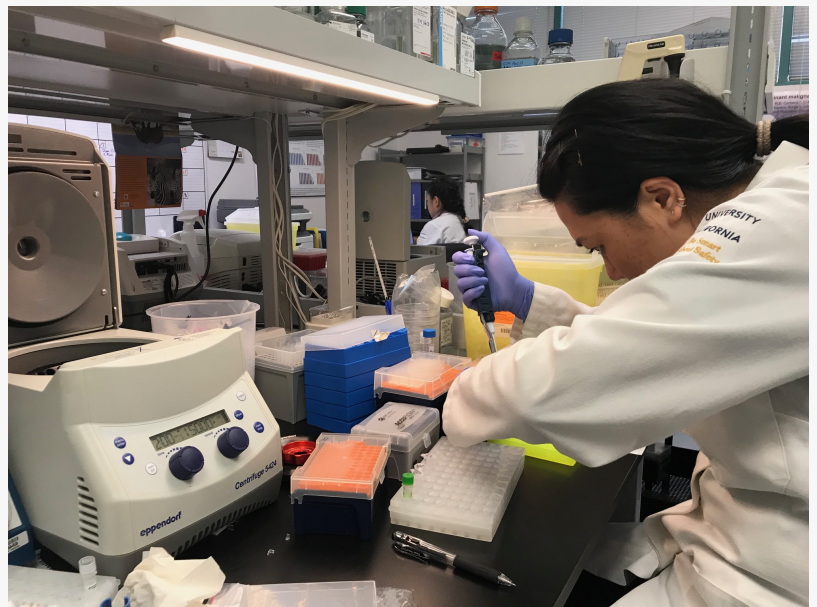
The Pacific Meso Center at The Pacific Heart, Lung & Blood Institute has announced new appointments to their Board of Directors & Marketing Advisory Committee.
