



Call For Nominations: NAMIC Next Generation Leaders Awards

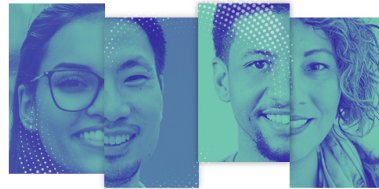
*Honoring Multi-Ethnic Leaders During
