Admission is free (vendors will charge patrons for food and drinks). All funds raised will benefit the Beatty Children's College Fund.

John Gallina, CEO and Co-Founder of Purple Heart Homes, is delighted to launch the first of this annual event in memory of his friend, partner, and battle buddy Dale Beatty and his father Jerry. "It's a fitting event for them," he said.
