"It's something we only talked about within the family and we always knew my grandfather was full Cherokee," she says "so when it came to casting this, I chose to cast women of color to honor what I was never allowed to explore in



my own life." Noreen Quadir and Piyali Syam both identify as women of color and ethnicity, but both had the same middle-class American upbringing as Church.
