Individuals in the state of Iowa could have been exposed to asbestos while serving in the US Navy working at a power plant, at an industrial facility, at a steel mill, at an automobile manufacturing facility, at a chemical plant, as a plumber, a boiler technician, as an auto repairman, as an electrician, or in the construction industry. In most instances, the diagnosed person's exposure to asbestos occurred in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's. www.karstvanoiste.com/

According to the American Cancer Society for nonsmokers who have been exposed to asbestos in their workplace the risk of lung cancer is five times that of unexposed workers.
