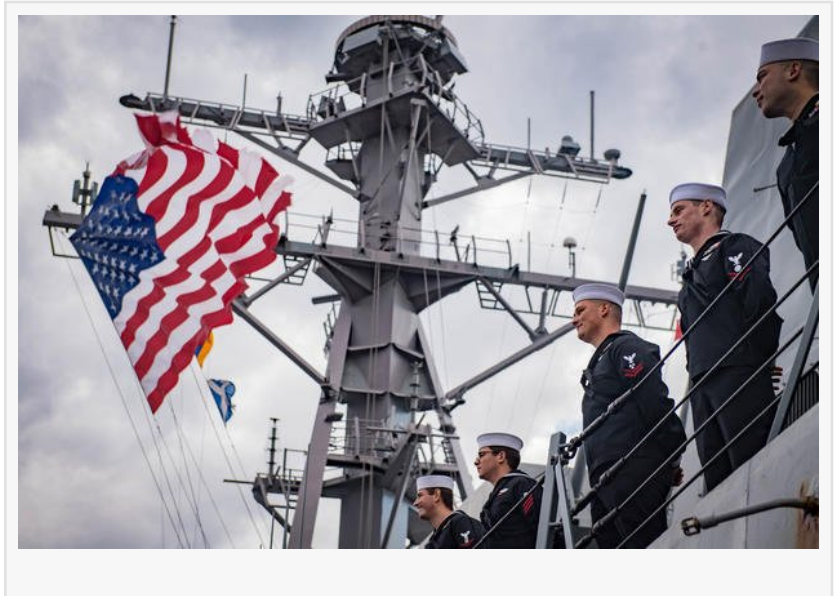

In most instances, the diagnosed person's exposure to asbestos occurred in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's. www.karstvonoste.com/
