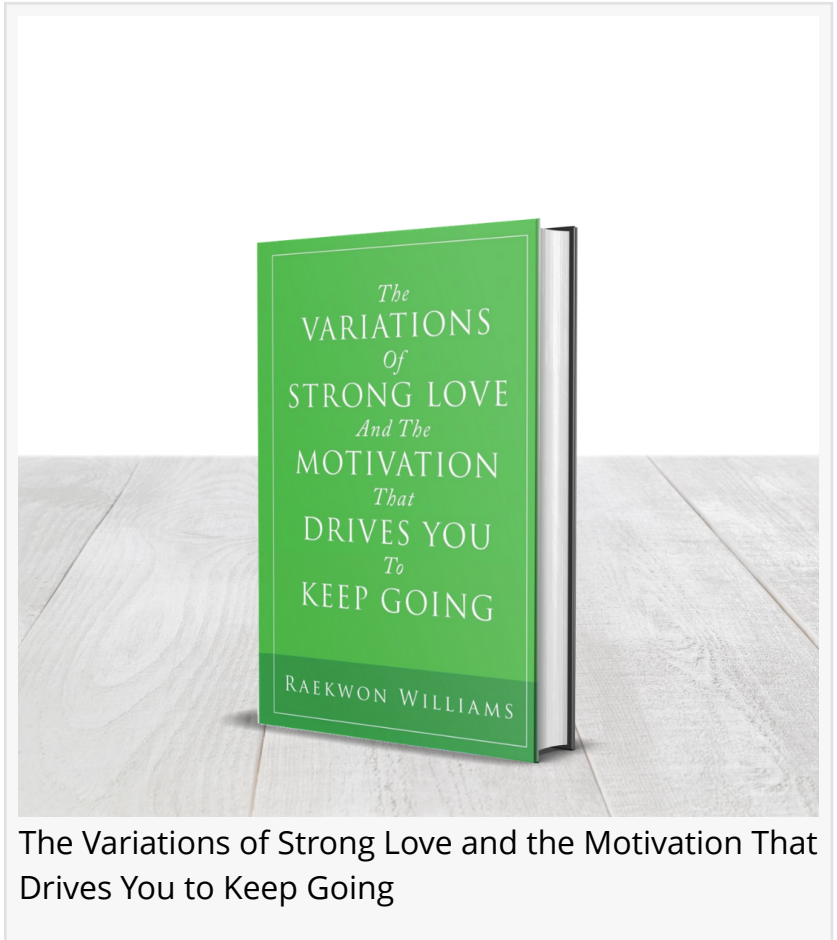
A young author embarks on spreading love and motivation
