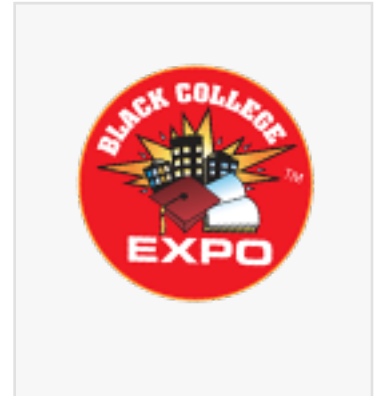


National College Resources Foundation Hosts Virtual New York/East Coast Black College Expo
