"Something we're really proud of is how Surge has been able to be so effective and efficient with the capital we're providing," added Robinson.

Surge for Water is hosting a virtual gala sponsored by SBB Research Group, "Dance Through the Decades," which will feature professional dance performances, a silent auction, and other unique presentations to raise awareness and funds for the organization's projects.
