

# Supervisor of Elections Wendy Sartory Link To Host Telephone Town Halls With Voters

*Four Telephone Town Halls will Provide an Overview of the 2020 General Election and Answer Voter Questions*


As part of that effort, Supervisor of Elections Wendy Sartory Link will host four telephone town halls with voters. Supervisor Link will share information on Voting-By-Mail, Early Voting schedule, Election Day information, poll worker opportunities and cybersecurity updates. There will also be an update on all polling location safety guidelines, including those related to the pandemic.

Recognizing how the COVID-19 pandemic has made it more difficult to interact with voters in traditional

meetings, events and engagement activities, the Supervisor of Elections office is working around the clock to make sure voters have all the information they need to vote.

There will be a total of four telephone town halls. They will be held on:

- \* Thursday, October 22nd at 6:00 p.m.
