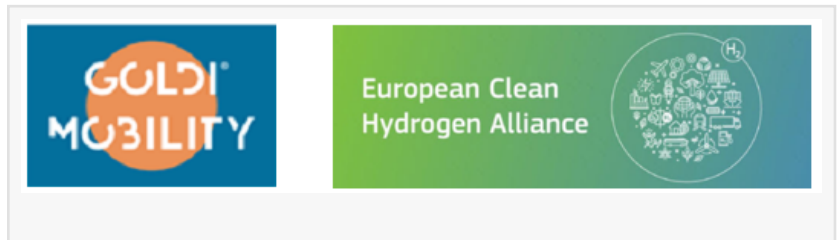


GOLDI Mobility Kft Joins European Clean Hydrogen Alliance
