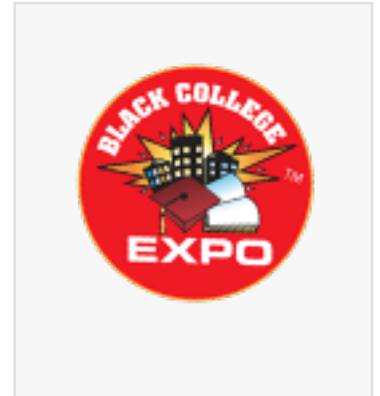


Black College Expo™ featured on "CBS This Morning" with Gayle King is Virtual for Atlanta/Miami students
