

# Methanol Institute Organizes Methanol as a Diesel Substitute Webinar

The webinar will feature speakers from ClearFlame Engine Technologies, DOR Motors, and FUELSAVE, who will present about how methanol is increasingly becoming a diesel substitute.

Methanol has a long history as a road transport fuel, and it is starting to make in-roads into the maritime sector as a marine fuel. In the past, interest in methanol as a fuel was largely driven by its high-octane level that can enhance the performance of vehicles. As a fuel, it can be blended with gasoline or used neat, and it was commonly used in high-performance racing cars.

Recent interest in methanol is largely driven by the global trend to bolster sustainability and accelerate decarbonization. Methanol's clean-burning properties allow it to offer immediate emission reductions when combusted in Internal Combustion Engines (ICEs). Methanol's ability to be produced from renewable feedstocks such as captured CO<sub>2</sub> and municipal solid waste (MSW) allows it to be a carbon-neutral fuel aligned with the global agenda to decarbonize the transport sector.

As a liquid chemical that has been widely traded for more than a century, existing infrastructure and technologies can be used to store, transport, and utilize methanol as a transport fuel, enabling a cost-efficient transition to more sustainable mobility.
