

Dental Bone Graft Substitute Market Rebounds in Europe following a Disastrous Performance Due to COVID-19

While the overall market experienced a sharp economic contraction due to the COVID-19 pandemic, iData forecasts that the growth in allograft products, demographic factors, technological



developments, and more will encourage significant growth.

According to iData's European Dental Bone Graft Substitute Report, the European market was estimated at just over €151 million in 2020. The 2020 market value experienced a 31% decrease from €219 million in 2019, following COVID-19 headwinds. However, the market has started to recover moving into 2021 and is expected to exceed €277 million by 2027. This report includes unit sales, average selling prices, market drivers and limiters, competitive market share analysis, procedure numbers, and more.

iData's analysis includes dental bone graft substitutes, dental growth factors, and dental barrier membranes (DBM's). As patient demand for dental implant procedures, quantified by iData, increases, the potential number of cases that require a bone grafting procedure also increases. This, in turn, generates demand for dental bone graft substitutes, barrier membranes, and dental growth factor products, such as Emdogain[®]. A major trend in the dental bone graft substitute and other biomaterials market is the growth of allograft products in Europe. Most countries are experiencing double-digit growth in allograft products due to their effectiveness.

Among the many competitors within these markets, Geistlich, Botiss Biomaterials, and Zimmer Biomet are the leaders followed by Straumann Group, ACE Surgical, and Bioteck. Non-profit tissue banks are also present within this market as they are generally involved in the production and distribution of allograft bone graft materials across Europe.
