

"REG" is a Deeply Thought-provoking Look at Life, Love, and Humankind's Ultimate Destiny in the Universe

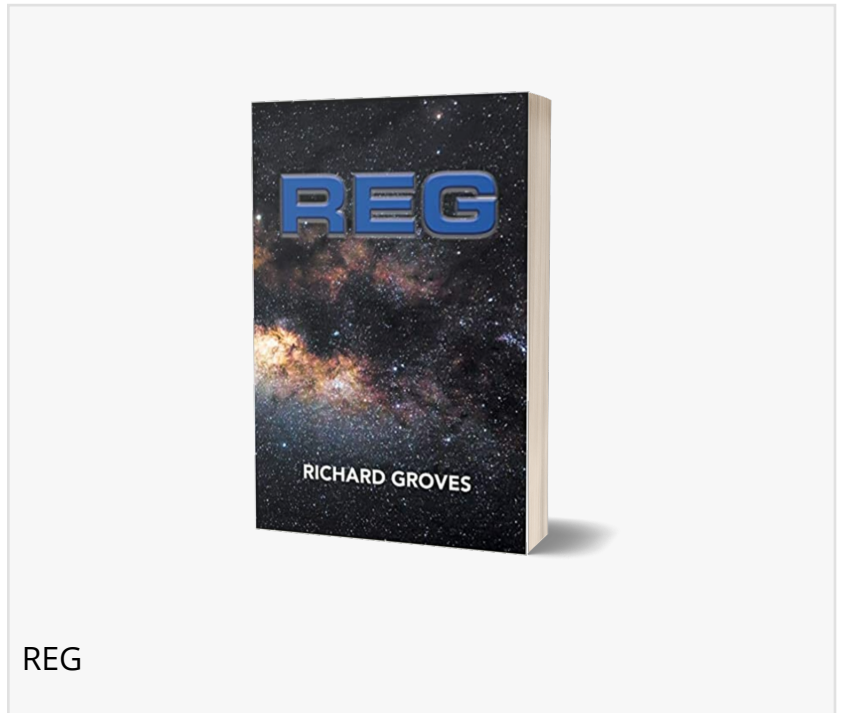
"REG" by Richard Groves is perfect for anyone who is looking for a story that is funny, witty, and chock-full of humor and supernatural adventures.
