To qualify for the 10,000 BreezePoints (a value of \$100 and the equivalent of one roundtrip) applicants must create a Guest account at www.flybreeze.com for the person seeking to travel and fill out a short application, using the email address associated with the Guest account. Applicants should list the reason for travel and how their visit will help rebuild homes, revitalize the city or provide volunteer services to its residents. Applications will be reviewed on a first-come, first served basis and must be received by September 22, 2021. Successful applicants will have Certificates within two weeks. Up to 10,000 applicants will be selected and notified by email with a BreezePoints Certificate which they can then claim in their account to book travel. Travel must be completed by February

14, 2022, but bookings must be completed by October 31, 2021, or the BreezePoints will expire.
