

Judge Malcolm Simmons Advises Maldives Judicial Service Commission


Judge Malcolm Simmons to roll out judicial performance evaluation policy in Maldives

WASHINGTON, WASHINGTON DC, UNITED STATES, September 10, 2021 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Judge Malcolm Simmons recently arrived in the Maldives and is currently working with the Judicial Service Commission to roll out a new judicial performance evaluation policy.

On 9 September Judge Simmons delivered a presentation to the Chief Justice of the Maldives, the Chair of the Judicial Service Commission, the Attorney General and judges of the Maldives Supreme Court and High Court, explaining the purpose of judicial performance evaluation and the policy that has been adopted by judicial administrators in the Maldives.

During his presentation, Judge Malcolm Simmons stated: "All systems of evaluation share the common premise that the professionalism of the judge represents both the

main source of legitimacy of the judicial function and a strong guarantee of its independence."
