

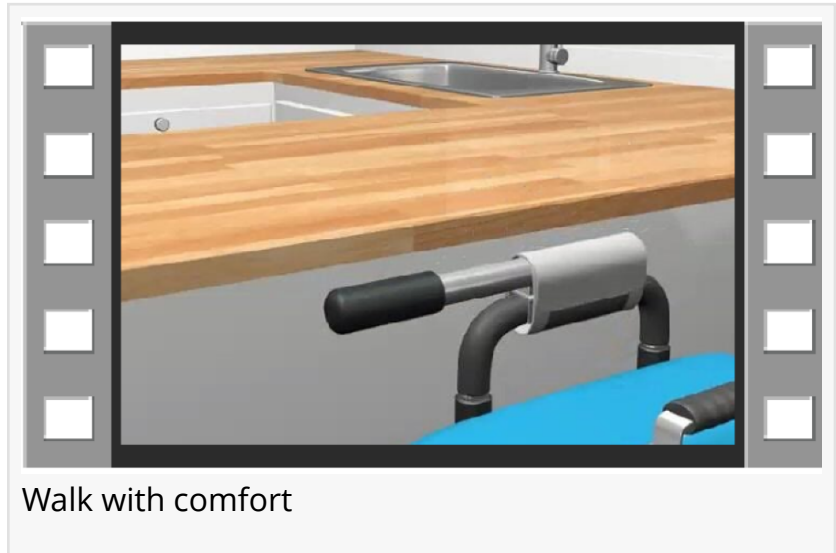
InventHelp Inventor Develops Accessory for Wheeled Luggage
