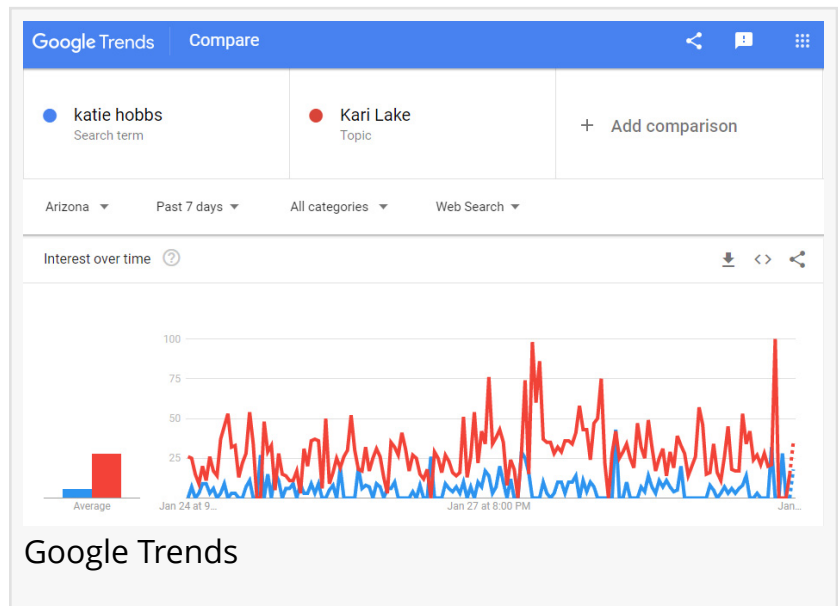


The Published Reporter® Releases Exclusive Interview with Arizona Frontrunner Kari Lake
