

The Advocate Strongly Encourages the Family of a Navy Veteran with Lung Cancer in Florida to Call Attorney Erik Karst of Karst von Oiste if Before 1982 he had Navy Asbestos Exposure-Compensation May Exceed \$100,000

TAMPA, FLORIDA, USA, March 31, 2022 /EINPresswire.com/ -- The Florida US Navy Veterans Lung Cancer Advocate says, "If your husband or dad is a Navy Veteran who has just been diagnosed with lung cancer anywhere in Florida, please call attorney Erik Karst of Karst von Oiste at 800-714-0303 if before 1982 they had significant exposure to asbestos on a navy ship, submarine or at a navy shipyard. Financial compensation for a person like this might exceed \$100,000 and the claim does not involve a lawsuit against the navy. Additionally, it does not matter if the person smoked cigarettes.



"What does matter is the Navy Veteran with recently diagnosed lung cancer can recall the specifics of how they were exposed to asbestos in the navy. To qualify the Navy Veteran must have been diagnosed with lung cancer within the last 12 months and their asbestos exposure must have occurred before 1982.

High-risk work groups for exposure to asbestos now living in Florida include US Navy Veterans, power plant workers, shipyard workers, oil refinery workers, steel mill workers, miners, manufacturing workers, public utility workers, plumbers, welders, electricians, auto mechanics, machinists, or construction workers. Most people who are diagnosed in Florida were



probably exposed to asbestos in the Northeast or Midwest. Typically, the exposure to asbestos occurred in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's.
