The newly commissioned facilities enable IBA Group to maintain continuous operation of its delivery, production, and support divisions in the event of unfavorable developments in any of the countries where IBA Group has software development centers.

The scope of this six-month-long project included:

- •Brocurement of relevant hardware and software
- •Installation works and solution of emerging telecommunication issues
- Treation of two production landscapes under Red Hat and VMware virtualization
- reation of a DevOps landscape based on the IBA Cloud Platform, the IBA Group's proprietary open source software solution
- •Betup of the backup and replication mechanisms
- •Revision of the IBA Group's Infrastructure Management Method-of-Procedure, and standard and emergency operation plans and instructions

Since mid-February, the new facility has been available for migration of corporate and project resources from other IBA Group data centers, as well as for creation of new high capacity production and development environments.
