High-risk work groups for exposure to asbestos in Idaho include US Navy Veterans, workers at the Naval Reactors Facility outside of Idaho Falls, miners in Northern Idaho, power plant workers, public utility workers, manufacturing workers, smelter workers, pulp or paper mill workers, carpenters, plumbers, electricians, auto mechanics, machinists, or construction workers. In most instances these types of people were exposed to asbestos in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's.
