This extension was designed by the author Noccito after hundreds of hours reading through

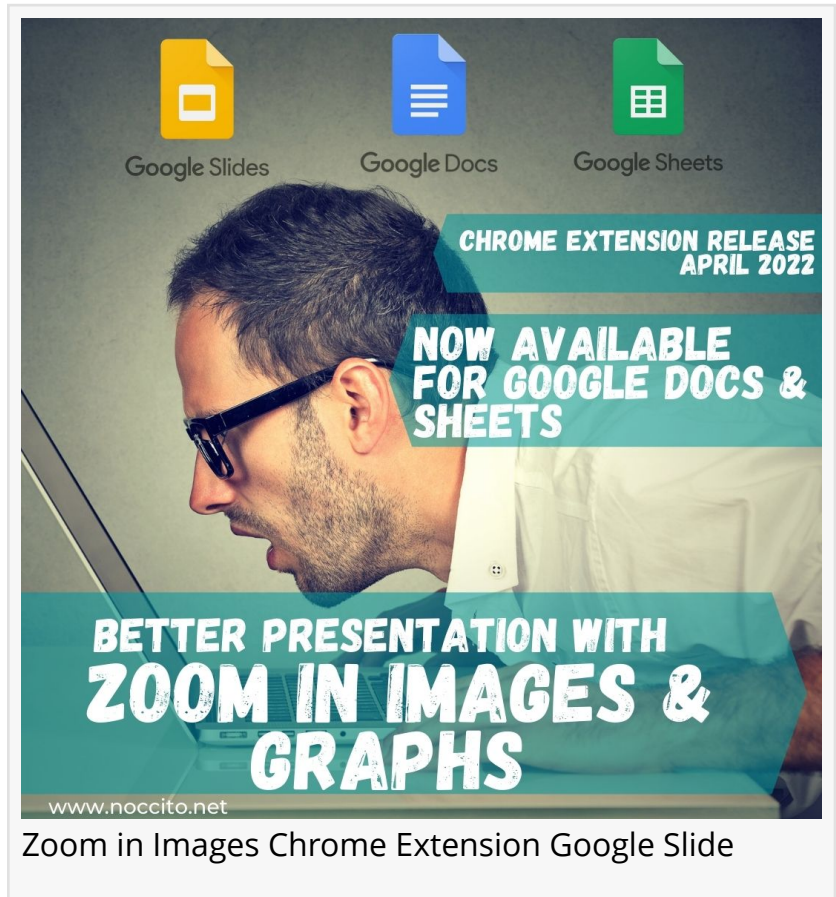

What it does?



Zoom in Images Chrome Extension Google Slide

It lets users Zoom In & Out of any Graphs, Tables, Images in a Presentation. It works both in Edit and Presentation mode.

Who is the primary audience?

- For Teachers and Students. The teacher can dive into a specific graph or information to help students focus on a specific point.
- For Financial presentation As a reader you can zoom in on a financial table to better analyze the figures.
- For anyone designing or using basic process maps. They are generally very difficult to read.
- For Product introduction, where you can zoom in on some specific design of the product.

Who can use it?

It is a free secure chrome extension for Google Slides, so anyone using chrome can download the extension for free.

What is the security?

It does not access or collect any data whether personal or other. It is actually a simple chrome extension, but the results make such an impact in a presentation.
