They include Cam Clarke, Townsend Coleman, and Barry Gordon, best known as the voices behind Leonardo, Raphael, Donatello, and Michelangelo.

Lastly, Kari Wahlgren has joined the guest roster and is widely known as the voice of Jessica in the extremely popular show 'Rick and Morty' featured on Adult Swim and Cartoon Network, in addition to a long list of many other cartoon and anime shows.

Aside from the notable voice acting talent in attendance, Sci-Fi Valley Con also hosts nearly 300 vendors, tons of charity events, cosplay, video games, tabletop games, and open Q&A guest panels with the celebrity guests and artists.
