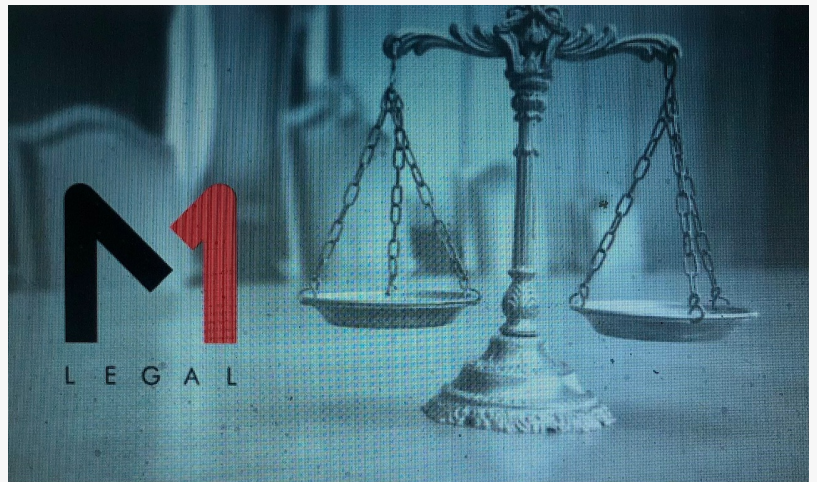


M1 Legal secures £73,600 timeshare compensation award secured by Europe's leading firm of timeshare lawyers
