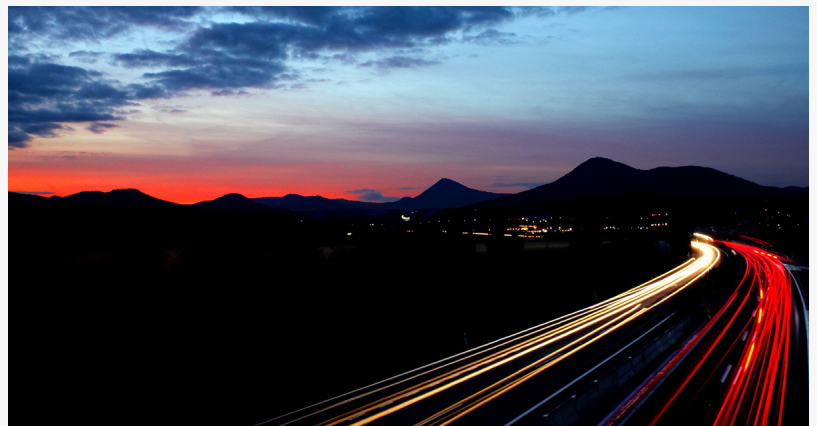


Albuquerque Expands Automated Speed Enforcement Program
