


## Supply Chain Blues

Freddie King, Muddy Waters, Howlin' Wolf, and Otis Rush. Early on in Young's career, BB King took notice of him and became his mentor having Young open for him on numerous occasions. "When I met BB King the first time, it was the day the Twin Towers fell. We sat in stunned silence together watching the event unfold on a TV in the back of his tour bus. I feel a special bond with BB that will last me for the rest of my life. I included The Thrill Is Gone on my new album in honor of his memory."

Young chose to name his new album "Supply Chain Blues" after a song on the album he co-wrote

based upon experiencing post pandemic frustration while attempting to buy a new Gibson semihollow body guitar. Young has been unable to get his hands on one. Fortunately there weren't any supply chain issues when it came time to go in the studio and start recording what Young feels is his best album yet. He did have to take a few days off to fly to Chicago and St. Louis to open for George Thorogood and Sammy Hagar, but enjoyed taking a break from laying tracks to visit with old friends on the road and connect with his ever growing fan base.
