Over 80% of Filipinos in the UAE prefer property investment as their primary investment preference, according to a survey conducted by the Philippine Property and Investment Exhibition (PPIE) 2022. 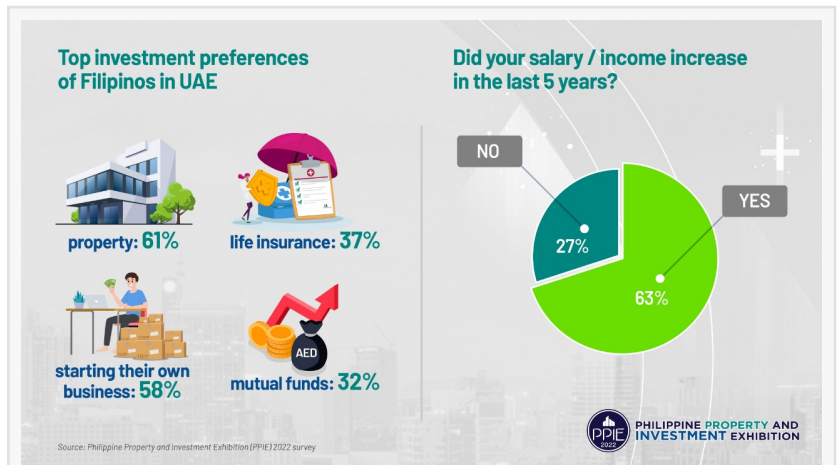

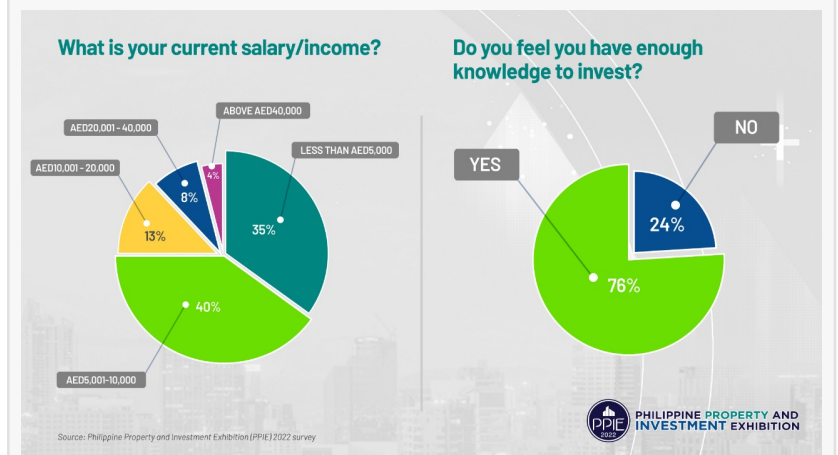

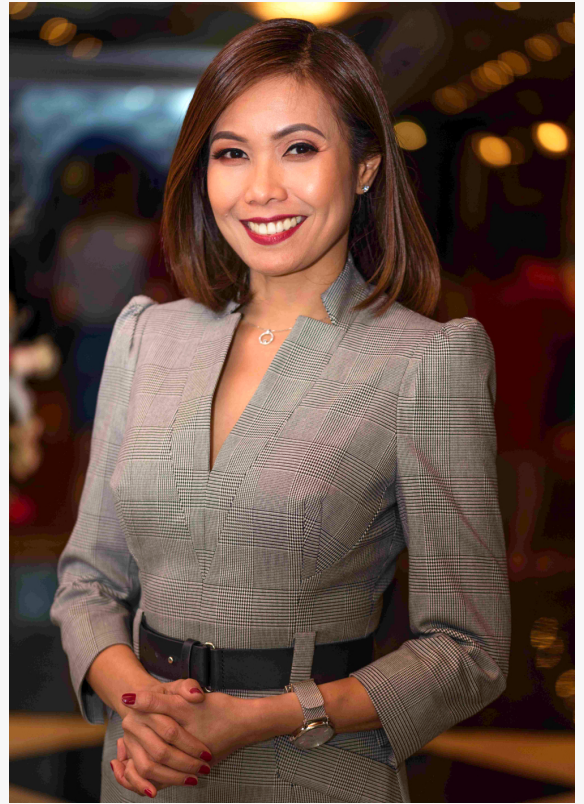
