The CTA has the authority of all of these groups to promote and to take control of the secession process to establish the world's newest country, the Cape is (short for The United Cape States). The Cape, situated at the south-

western tip of Africa, became part of South Africa in 1910, with the formation of the Union of South Africa. But to this day the Cape remains very different from the rest of South Africa.
