Kevin Anton cast as Harley Race.



Most recently, Anton appeared in Showtime's seven-part limited series, The Loudest Voice, based on a bestselling book about Roger Ailes, the founder of Fox News. He can also be seen in the upcoming Amazon series, Dead Ringers, starring Rachel Weisz. Anton is repped by Stefanie Talent and

The Iron Claw began principal photography beginning in Louisiana in October, and is expected to finish sometime in December. A24 has yet to publish a release date, but the consensus is that the film will premiere sometime in 2023.
