CFI's delivery to Washington D.C. will be made by professional driver Don Welch, who has driven for CFI for 33 years and has over 3.6 million safe driving miles. In addition to Arlington, CFI drivers – all who are veterans of military service – are delivering wreaths to sites in Kansas, Missouri, Texas and Virginia.

Mr. Welch is an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S. Army and did tours of duty in Germany and Panama. For the delivery to Arlington, he is piloting one of seven unique CFI "<u>True to the Troops</u>" tractor-trailers, which feature special large format "wrap" graphics that cover the entire

vehicle, and depict honorable military imagery, honoring members of each branch and their

service to the country. The Arlington deliveries are slated for Saturday, December 17.
