It will look better for future employment, although you can start picking up PRN shifts on the side once you're beyond preceptorship/orientation at your staff job and are comfortable with your tasks and responsibilities as a registered nurse. Here are some tips on finding a job as a new graduate and how to find an RN job near you.

Do an online search. There's a great demand for nurses, and you will find plenty to choose from. Try an RN job app that puts you in direct communication with the hospital and vice-versa. This allows you to pick up shifts as needed and helps facilities with on-demand RNs.

Visit local job fairs or a University.

Try some nursing apps, set up a profile, and apply for per diem RN jobs near you.

Have a good resume, and include any special abilities you have. It could be speaking multiple languages. You want your resume to set you apart, and being unique will do just that. Job Responsibilities of An RN:

As a nursing graduate, you must have the knowledge and skills to carry out the task an RN should be able to perform, although many facilities operate differently. Different specialties within nursing exist, such as where you work and the type of care you give will determine your duties, but here's a list of typical responsibilities an RN may perform.

Give, and monitor medication.

Inserting and managing catheters.

Making out a care plan for a patient.

Assessing with proper intervention.

Taking vital signs while recognizing any abnormalities.

Admitting and discharging of patients.

Thorough documentation.

Assisting patients in and out of their beds.

Basic life support.

Taking care of wounds.

Cleaning, feeding, and aiding in patient hygiene.

Keeping the patients safe.

Some registered nurses are comfortable working in the same place day in and day out, receiving their benefits and expected salaries their employer gives them. Whereas working per diem is for others who want freedom in their lifestyles.
