The post-pandemic surge shows an uptick in small business development of some 198% in predominantly Black areas. Through the partnership with CoBiz, NorCal SBDC, and the Inclusivity Project, residents will have access to tools and resources to elevate their businesses such as access to live webinars, expert instructors, and



weekly Q&A sessions with SBDC advisors.

The program kicks off with a virtual welcome meeting on Wednesday, January 25th at 10:00 AM, hosted by STEM expert Dr. LaVonne Slaton. Attendees can register at bit.ly/3X2uW3T.
