The most common type of upholstery cleaning is steam cleaning or hot water extraction. This

type of upholstery cleaning can help to remove dirt, dust, debris, stains, odors, and other various spots or spills. Spot cleaning is great for dealing with spills as they happen, but professional upholstery cleaning solutions are designed to clean and sanitize the entire piece. Utilizing hot steam to bloom the fibers, and high-pressure suction to extract the refuse, professional upholstery cleaning provides the right results. Investing in professional cleaning is recommended every 9 to 12 months to help extend the life of the furniture.

Additionally, upholstery cleaning, along with various other steam cleaner services, has been shown to improve indoor air quality. When the dust settles, it always settles onto surfaces like couches, chairs, and carpets. Steam cleaning helps to remove these allergens from the home similar to an air purifier.

discuss the factors involved in determining the upholstery cleaning price. The cost of professional upholstery cleaning can vary depending on a number of factors, which will be discussed below. Note this is not a completely comprehensive list. New advancements are happening every day, but for the most part, professional cleaners will follow pricing guidelines similar to this.

First and foremost, consider the piece of furniture to be cleaned. Office chairs will be priced differently than a sectional couch, for example. It might be easier to understand how pricing is determined from an example. Consider an 8-foot couch, with connected cushions, several pillows, and metal studs lining the seams of the couch.

The size of the couch and the amount of fabric are both important factors to consider. If the

arms and legs are wooden, the price may decrease slightly. The metal studs also need to be taken into consideration as each stud must be dried by hand once the cleaning is done to avoid rusting. Some companies offer pricing that includes all pillows and cushions, but others might not, so it's important to clarify this. Additionally, expect to pay different prices based on the color of the fabric.



One more factor to consider is the type of fabric that needs cleaning. Crushed

velvet, for example, requires special attention after the cleaning that most other fabrics don't need. Leather is treated differently from any other type of fabric, and requires an entirely different set of products. That said, cotton, microfiber, and linen, the most common types of upholstery fabric, can all be cleaned with steam.

Of course, there are also other circumstances when it comes to furniture. Anything requiring additional treatment will factor into the total price. Spots or stains, marks from pets rubbing against the couch, or other types of pet stains, must all be considered. The professional will notice these things once the cleaning begins, and they may need to adjust the price accordingly. Always be transparent with the technician to ensure the right treatments and products are being used.
