Walid Al-Samaani. “It aims to enhance digital enablers facilitating access to justice, consolidate safeguards in digital judicial applications, exchange expertise and best practices, enhance international relations, and highlight the latest international trends in judicial sectors.”

now provides over 150 electronic services related to courts, notarization, enforcement and conciliation; among others.”
