

Week-long global celebration for educators that promotes 'open' solutions to education challenges

From 6 to 10 March education practitioners from 37 countries will host 455 OEWeek events to raise awareness about the effectiveness of their open solutions.

It also shares a free-to-access library of 708 educational resources created for educators and students alike to actively benefit from materials developed under open licenses.

Organized by [Open Education Global \(OEGlobal\)](#), the 2023 edition takes place from the 6th to the 10th of March 2023, around the world. There are over 450 registered events and 166 student-focused open resources in 19 languages. The events and resources have been submitted by more than 209 globally dispersed individuals, projects, and organizations that are actively focused on open education work.
