

Sacramento Drug Free World Chapter Promotes Drug Awareness to Families and Groups on World Health Day

The Sacramento Chapter Director of the Foundation For A [Drug-Free World](#) Mr. Nathan Johnson added "that the health of our kids is of paramount importance due to the many dangers of

today's drugs."

By way of example the Fentanyl crisis prompted the Sacramento City Unified School District to vote in October of 2022 to become one of the first in the state to distribute Narcan, which can help treat a suspected Fentanyl overdose. The board decision was in response to increasing opioid deaths in the County and the introduction of "rainbow Fentanyl" in California. "From marijuana laced candies to fake pills laced with the deadly drug Fentanyl, kids need to be accurately informed and empowered with the 'Truth about Drugs' that can quite literally save lives " added Mr. Johnson.

In all, the Chapter got out over 700 materials to nearly 300 families that attended the Lembi Park event and hosted several members of other groups at the Church that each received materials.

"We have partnered locally with Steered Straight Founder Michael Deleon who provides a wealth of experience and insight to engage youth on the subject of drugs with today's facts and figures" added Mr. Johnson.

"The Church of Scientology proudly supports these drug prevention initiatives." Referring to the devastating impact of drugs on society, author, humanitarian and Scientology Founder L.
