The Summon Platform launches, April 26th, 2023. It enables DAOs on Cardano through an intuitive user interface

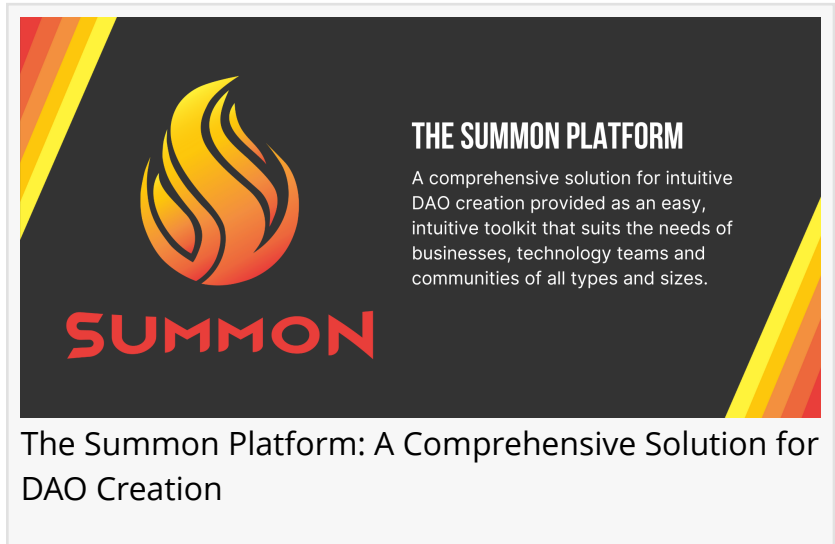

The platform, running on the Cardano Blockchain, is designed to unlock the ability for anyone to create or

participate in Decentralized Autonomous Organizations (DAOs) through an intuitive user interface. User communities will gain access to critical governance, treasury, and digital asset management infrastructure to leverage the security, cost efficiency, and performance of the fifth largest Layer-1 blockchain by market capitalization.

At launch, platform users will have the ability to establish Communities with associated [Multi-Signature Wallets and sub-community wallets](#) that can meet a wide range of treasury management use cases. Community Managers will be able [survey community members through polls and proposals](#) according to membership lists or blockchain-wide wallet snapshots that can be token-weighted in the platform's innovative Polling Module. Enterprise users will be able to integrate Summon Platform modules into their standalone applications with Summon APIs.

The public launch of the Summon Platform represents a significant milestone in the mission to advance decentralized governance and secure digital asset management technologies on Cardano. "The Summon team is excited to offer a simple and intuitive way for organizations to manage their decision-making processes and digital assets in a highly secure and transparent manner," says Riley Kilgore, Head of Development. "We look forward to continued innovation and growth, and to building out a no-code platform that is user-friendly for all."

Beyond DAOs, the Summon Platform is designed to meet the needs of a wide range of users and use cases. "The Summon Platform isn't just for projects with a lot of digital assets or a large user



base to coordinate,” says Adam Rusch, Summon Association President. “We are making sure this platform is equally accessible to the everyday users, whether it be a few friends who want to hold some NFTs together or an individual who wants to set up a family trust with a Multisig.”

The Summon team has been actively involved with blockchain technologies for years and helped found ADAO Community (<https://theadao.io>), the first DAO on the Cardano Blockchain. ADAO was responsible for the development and promotion of the popular [RoundTable Multi-Signature Wallet](#) (V1 and V2), a free and open source tool. RoundTable was the first Cardano Multi-Sig dapp made widely available and remains the standard for users managing jointly controlled assets.
