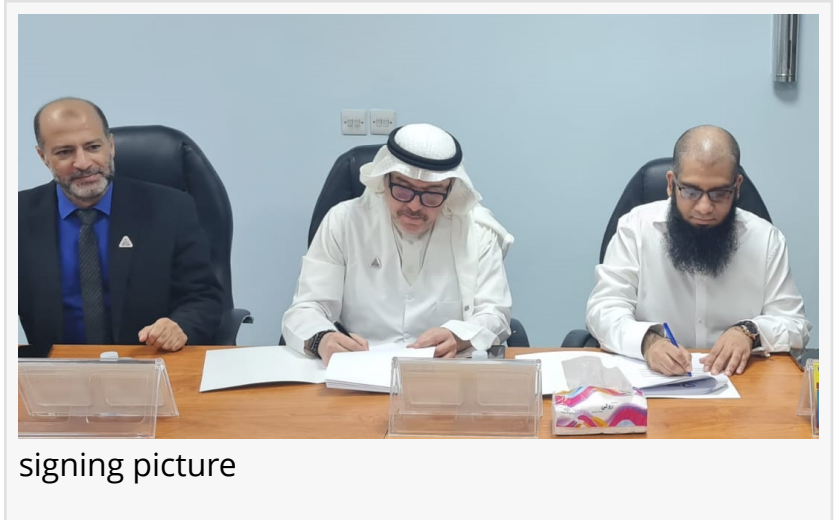


Belahodoud to offer LRN ESOL Qualifications in Medina, Saudi Arabia
