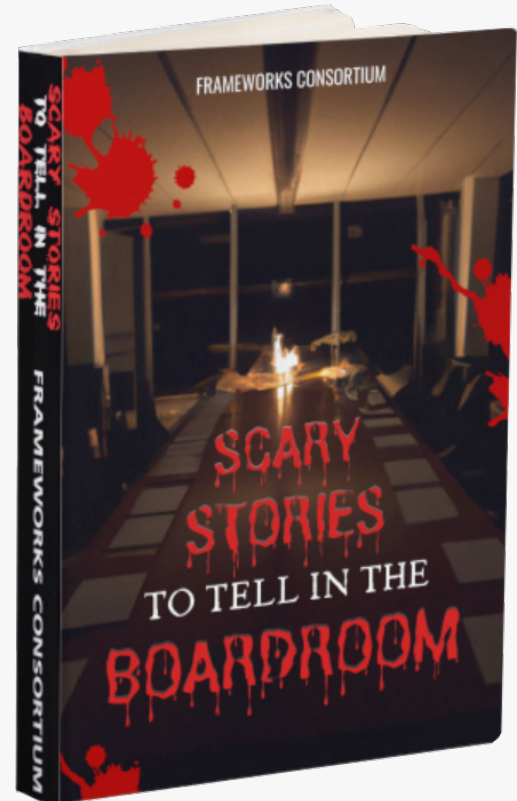

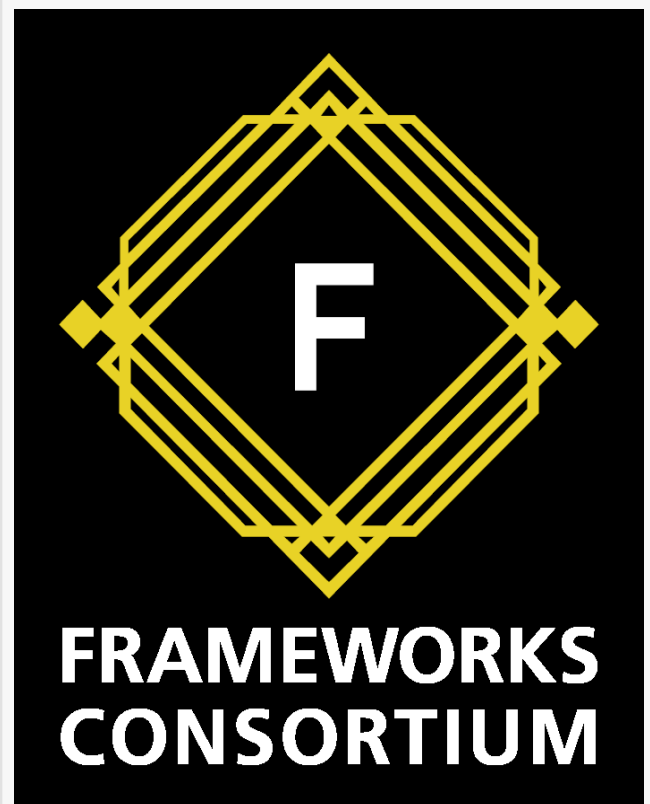
Moreover, Frameworks Consortium is planning to hold speaking events upon the book's release where the authors will be able to deliver even more wisdom to attendees.
