


Austin Dentist on the Advantages of Laser Dentistry

• Precise, customizable energy levels. The Waterlase[®] MD Laser Dentistry system emits small, intense beams of light

to target hard and soft tissue. "Whereas a scalpel tends to harshly cut into tissue, the Waterlase[®] ablates the tissue, which limits the opportunity for damage," Dr. Sweeney explains. The settings are completely customizable, which gives the dentist complete control over the device and the

ability to directly address specific concerns.

• Increased comfort. Laser treatments are designed to be much gentler than traditional methods, says Dr. Sweeney. The absence of sutures and stitches generally makes for a much more comfortable procedure with little to no bleeding or pain. Dr. Sweeney also notes that no injections or sutures are typically necessary. "Patient comfort is our top priority at Austin Dental Spa, as well as one of the main reasons we choose to employ lasers at our practice," he explains.

• Defense against infection. At Austin Dental Spa, Dr. Sweeney's experienced hygienists often use a diode laser to conduct deep cleanings. According to Dr. Sweeney, this type of laser can be placed on "Sterile Mode" to thoroughly cleanse the mouth of harmful bacteria.

• No unpleasant sounds. Anxiety about dental work can discourage patients from attending the dentist, says Dr. Sweeney. "Often, loud drilling noises and other intrusive sounds can increase a patient's anxiety," he states, "but the laser mitigates this issue completely."

• Faster procedure and recovery. According to Dr. Sweeney, high-speed laser energy can significantly speed up healing. "Laser dental treatments can be completed in as little as 10 minutes," he adds.

To conclude, Dr. Sweeney states that he is excited about future developments in laser dentistry. "New lasers come onto the market every year," he says, "and by using them, my team and I hope to continue to improve our patients' experience in every way."
