


Palm Beach Modern Auctions Hosts Unique Boutique Sale of Global Artwork on Behalf of Tupperware® Corporate Collection

Nearly 300 artworks by American, Brazilian, Japanese and Mexican artists will be auctioned off this Saturday, May 6 at Palm Beach Modern Auction's boutique sale

EINPresswire.com/ -- "This Saturday's auction is one you do not want to miss," said Rico Baca, co-owner and auctioneer at Palm Beach Modern Auctions. Since 2022, Palm Beach Modern Auctions has been working with Tupperware Brands Corporation to auction the company's varietal art collection, and Saturday's event will be the third installment.



Totaling over 800 pieces offered over Palm Beach Modern's 2022-2023 auction season, this collection is not only the largest brought to auction by PBMA, but the most colorful as well.

The works represent several genres and styles: geometric abstracts, color field paintings, landscapes, botanical scenes, and florals. Many are by central Florida artists, including works by Doris Leeper of DeLand, Steve Lotz of Orlando and Luis Sottil of Tampa. To the delight of Baca, the careers of a few artists had exploded in the intervening years.

"While unloading storage, we discovered this incredibly beautiful, double-sided Sam Gilliam watercolor. One side is a softer abstract, but the other – my personal favorite – has these brilliant swimming pool blue, fuchsia and lilac tones, some almost neon, and touches of aluminum powder and metallics as well. It's worth seeing in person," says Baca.

Other gems include two Jorge Marin kinetic sculptures from their lobby, bronze acrobats measuring 95-inches and 103-inches high. Several sets of Warren Platner lounge chairs, table lamps, tapestries and other pieces are featured, as are noteworthy paintings such as a 92-inch

Jack Youngerman shaped canvas, a 90-inch Humberto Calzada surrealist triptych, and landscapes by Karl Schrag, Ethel Magafan, Deborah Brown, and Gabor Peterdi. Bidders can also find editions from Sam Francis, Gene Davis, Richard Anuszkiewicz, Tadashi Asoma, Robert Natkin, and Ilya Bolotowsky.

The auction will take place at Palm Beach Modern Auctions on Saturday, May 6, previewing concurrently with their May 20 Modern + Contemporary Art & Design sale. Lots can be viewed online at www.modernauctions.com or in person all week leading up to the sale.
