their medical case, or their current emotional conditions. The book "[Fighting to Survive](#)" is Judy Rentz' tell-all book that bares her own share of downs.

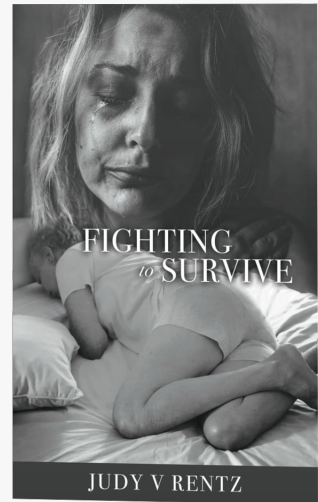
