Simultaneously, Robin has made a tremendous impact in the greater CACFP community by volunteering her time as a leader for NCA. She has served on the Board of Directors for 20 years, serving on the executive team and as chair of the Scholarship, CACFP Week, Membership, and Nominations committees.
