

Towles' political thriller, The Ridders, was a First Place Winner of the 2022 American Fiction Award and Second Place Winner of the Book Fest Award. Hot House (2022) was a #1 Amazon Kindle Bestseller and 1st place Winner of The Book Fest 2022 literary award. Salt Island won a Readers' Choice Award for Adult Fiction and a Literary Titan Award. In addition to writing, Towles loves supporting other authors. She speaks frequently to writing groups about marketing strategies and creativity, and has brought her Strategic Self Care platform to numerous literary

and entrepreneurial groups. Following Salt Island, Towles' standalone thriller Terror Bay is queued for release by Indies United Publishing on November 30, 2023.

Following Hot House, Salt Island is Book 2 in Towles' E&A Investigations series, where former CIA operative Mari Ellwyn rejoins her partner Derek Abernathy in a new, gripping crime thriller. Primarily set in Southern California, Salt Island's storyline follows Mari and Derek as they investigate a corporate espionage case, and then trace the roots of an eco-terrorism scandal in California's Central Valley. Underlying the E&A Series' mythology is Mari's endless search for her missing father, this time in the British Virgin Islands. Lured by compassion and ties to their former lives, Ellwyn and Abernathy leverage their collective experience in the biggest challenge of their lives – delivering justice and staying alive in the process. Salt Island will be published in Kindle, paperback, hardcover, and audiobook formats and will be available on Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Smashwords, and through all book retailers.

Towles works full-time in the tech industry, has an MBA in IT Management, and is Board President of Oakland-based nonprofit, BRIDGEGOOD.
