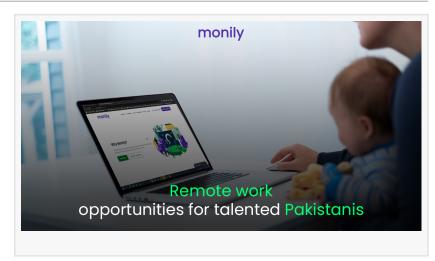


Monily Celebrates Landmark of Reaching 50 Accounting Team Members
