"Humans are comprised of over 30 trillion cells, which live in a complex nutrient-rich micro-environment made up of minerals, vitamins, amino acids and antioxidants," Horton explains. "Through IV and injection therapy, we can add those essential elements directly to the bloodstream, promoting improved cellular health and function."


Meet the Team

Bringing 60 years of combined clinical practice, the AquafylV team is passionate about helping the community

understand the value of IV therapy and complementary medicine.

After 10 years of nursing, Horton obtained his master's in nursing. Currently, board certified as an acute care nurse practitioner, he serves as medical director of AquafyIV while teaching at CU School of Medicine and working as a hospitalist. Mitchell left bedside nursing in the late 2000s to earn a master's in healthcare administration, and Meining is a local practicing nurse with over 20 years in perioperative care.

Therapies are only administered by the most qualified licensed personnel – registered nurses and nurse practitioners – and the medical director is available onsite for consultations. Clients are greeted by Daisha, Kaylin or Santiana who take a compassionate approach to guiding each individual through a comprehensive wellness experience.



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## Not an IV Bar

Over the last several years, many IV "bars" have popped up nationwide and across the Front Range. Horton emphasizes that AquafyIV is not a bar or franchise. These businesses may offer a limited list of retail infusions typically pre-purchased and premixed. Infusions are often administered by personnel with a range of backgrounds. And medical directors are commonly remote, providing offsite administrative and licensing oversight.

"You will never receive a one-dose-fits-all premixed infusion at AquafyIV," Horton says. "All infusions are customized based on an individual's needs, reconstituted aseptically in a controlled environment, ensuring the highest quality and quantity of ingredients."

Being a small, local business gives AquafyIV a unique opportunity. "We can really deliver care with a personalized approach that allows us to shift quickly to meet the needs of our patients while remaining ethical and building loyalty," says Horton.

For example, though most clients are coming in for elective services, AquafyIV team members have identified and diagnosed serious medical conditions and complications. "We then can provide treatment, provide a referral or partner with community providers to coordinate the best

care possible for our patients while deepening trust," he says.

## Most Popular Therapies

AquafyIV's most popular therapies focus on inflammatory conditions whether autoimmune, allergic, environmental, acquired or infectious. "Many disease processes are related to acute or chronic inflammatory states in the body," Horton explains. "We focus on decreasing oxidative stress and optimizing what our cells are already programmed to do."

But you don't have to have a disease state to benefit from AquafyIV. Many services are preventative. For example, business travelers come in before and after their work trips or family vacations.

"We also offer a multiday perioperative package that focuses on decreasing the oxidative stress induced during surgery while encouraging tissue healing and recovery, decreasing post-operative pain, reducing post-operative infectious risk and enhancing preoperative hydration when you are not allowed to eat or drink," Horton says.

Additionally, there are AquafyIV therapies designed to help boost immunity and energy; provide relief from overindulgence or pain; speed athletic recovery; improve mental clarity; stabilize mood; and promote beauty and anti-aging.

One particularly popular service is a comprehensive weight loss program that combines prescriptive and complementary alternative therapies to combat obesity. Clients get a medical screening, evaluation, monitoring, follow-up, medications and supplies for one set price, according to Horton. "As obesity is a chronic disease, we understand this is not a get-fixed-fast program, but our results are noticeable and measurable, which encourages and reinforces improved lifestyles that reduce weight."

## In the Community

As members of the Longmont Chamber of Commerce, AquafyIV builds relationships with local businesses that support the local economy. "In a time of healthcare provider shortage, we gainfully employ registered nurses and CNAs in a collaborative work environment," Horton says.

AquafyIV also contributes to local charities, most recently Roberta's Legacy, a foundation that assists families with financial difficulties during the breast cancer journey. "The connection makes sense: We have been recognized for our outcomes in adjunctive cancer therapies that reduce symptoms and improve quality of life during cancer treatment," explains Horton.

But, most importantly, AquafyIV is empowering everyone in the community to take charge of their health. "We are passionate about providing personalized quality care that's not just a luxury but also medical services which are priced to accommodate our underserved community," Horton says. "We believe combining traditional medicine with complementary alternative

therapies to hydrate the body, recharge the mind and rejuvenate life is the ultimate health and wellness experience. And we want everyone to have it."

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
