Roof Overlays: In cases of significant irregularities, a new roof overlay might be the solution. This involves installing a new, even layer over the existing roof. This not only corrects the unevenness but also provides an added layer of protection.

Roof Supports: Installing additional supports or joists can help even out pronounced dips or peaks. This is more structural in nature and ensures that the roof is stable and can bear weight uniformly.

Tapered Insulation: This is a two-in-one solution. Tapered insulation panels can be added to the roof, helping in leveling the surface and enhancing the insulation of the structure.

Regular Maintenance and Inspection: As with all structural elements, regular inspections can help identify and rectify minor issues before they escalate. "Preventive measures are always better than reactive solutions," notes Cangelosi.

Ensuring a Proactive Approach

Cully Cangelosi emphasizes the importance of early intervention. "The sooner unevenness is detected, the easier and more cost-effective the solutions are. It's essential for homeowners and building managers to have periodic roof inspections and not wait for visible signs of damage."
