


Modix Unveils "Core-Meter" – A Cost-effective 1-Cubic-Meter 3D Printer at Formnext in Germany, November 7-10, 2023

It is worth noting that the Core-Meter supports a single print head only while the BIG-Meter also supports the IDEX dual print head capabilities, designed for advanced multi material 3D printing.

Modix's entry into a second line of printers represents a pivotal strategic move, positioning the company as a comprehensive solution provider for the large-scale 3D printing market. Additionally, a range of supplementary add-ons, including enclosures, air filtration systems,

filament dryers, and more, will be made available for the Core-Meter.

- Accelerometer on the print head to minimize vibrations and enhance print quality.
- · Duet electronic controller.
- Llightweights yet potent Phaetus Rapido hotend and APUS extruder.
