

In the last 9 years, he has completed 176 peer reviews for twelve PubMed-indexed science journals. 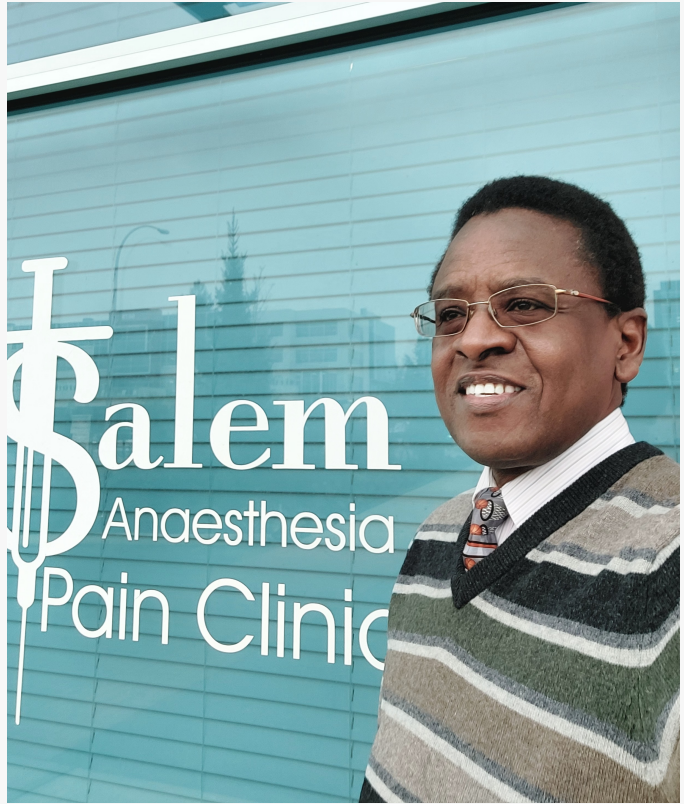


